Proposal for hosting ARSU summit meeting:

Basic rule from 2016 is:

- When IROS is held in the ARSU member country, the local society hosts the ARSU summit meeting at IROS site.
- Offer of hosting summit meeting is welcome, and if there is no specific offer, then KROS and RSJ host the summit meeting in turn, basically.
- Hosting includes arranging the meeting place and lunch, announcement of the meeting, and their budget.
- The host society is decided in the ARSU summit meeting two years in advance.
